- He/ She agrees to pay a pre-fixed amount as the Registration Charges
- The applications shall be judged on the basis of their contribution in fisheries, number
  of publications in reputed journals (with NAAS rating above 6.0), technology developed
  and commercialised, patents obtained, etc.
